

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

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Course Outline and Structure

Training Delivery

Training is delivered via Blended (Face-to-face training + Online distance learning) to be completed in up to 2 days with approximately 18 hours of study, depending on learner's skills, knowledge, and experience.

Assessment Methods:

- Observation during role play/simulations
- Questioning may include self-assessment, verbal answers, written questionnaires, activity modules or interview
- Structured Activities

What are the entry requirements?

There are no prerequisites required to enter this course. However, the RTO screens students according to the following criteria:

- Must be 18 years of age and over
- Have sound language, literacy, and numeracy skills* (at least Year 10 English, or equivalent)
- Have basic computer skill

Students must also be able to perform manual handling tasks safely.

Therefore, prospective students need to have the physical attributes to be able to:

- Bring themselves to floor level in order to perform the above task.
- Perform uninterrupted for two minutes single rescuer cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) (five (5) cycles of both compressions and ventilations.
- Have the physical capacity to perform manual handling tasks safely.

*Learners who do not meet the LLN requirements of the course may still enrol into the course provided the enrolment has been endorsed by the trainer and corresponding additional support strategies have been put in place.

Is Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) available?

Due to the high risk nature of these units, RPL is not offered. Refresher training in CPR must be carried out annually and first aid certifications must be renewed every three years.

What are the qualification pathways after taking the course?

Learners may also consider additional training to complement their skills in providing First Aid with courses/units such as:

- HLTAIDo10 Provide basic emergency life support*
- HLTAIDo12 Provide First Aid in an education and care setting*
- HLTAIDo13 Provide First Aid in remote or isolated site*
